A2 - Raw Draft:

"My city is beautiful. There are many buildings. People are friendly. I like museums."

Notes: No unity; ideas listed. Missing focus and coherence.

B1 – Guided Rewrite:

"My city feels beautiful because its river, old bridges, and weekend art shows make life relaxed and colorful..."

Notes: Unity maintained, clearer topic and better support.

C1 – Advanced Version:

"The city's beauty is not in monuments but in daily rhythm — evenings by the river, the glow of old bridges, and weekend art..."

Notes: Smooth coherence, syntactic variety, strong closure.
